

## POLICY STATEMENT: CHAPTER REVITALIZATION

## **PURPOSE**

To re-establish a chapter with inactive status.

## **BACKGROUND**

Chapters that have been inactive and want to re-establish themselves may do so at any time. Usually an interested member wants to re-establish a *viable* chapter. Membership in these chapters is not usually "organized" so that voting for a governing board cannot take place through usual procedures for elections.

## **PROCESS**

- 1. Interested parties should contact Chapter Support at <a href="mailto:chaptersupport@apna.org">chaptersupport@apna.org</a> and express an interest in the revitalization process. A conference call between the Executive Director, Chapter & Council Support Manager, and all parties will be scheduled to discuss this process to include the Chapter Affiliation Agreement.
- 2. A Temporary Leadership Committee (TLC) of 3 to 5 people depending on chapter size is created. The committee decides upon a Chapter Leader.
- 3. The TLC submits a Chapter Affiliation Agreement signed by the Chapter Leader. If one was already in place, the agreement is reviewed.
- 4. Indicate to the APNA Board of Directors that the chapter is viable. This can be done through the development of a chapter conference (for larger chapters) or through the creation and maintenance of regular meetings (for smaller chapters) that will include diverse geographic regions.
- 5. This committee will be in place for a year before elections will be held.
